1. Pass EDUC 200 (or equivalent course) with a grade of C or better
2. Achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
3. Pass the IL Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) **OR** receive a score of a least 22 on the ACT Plus Writing or a composite score of 1110 on the SAT evidence based reading, writing + mathematics
4. Be free of a felony sex or drug conviction
5. Complete the FBI and State of IL Fingerprint/Background check process

\*For Education Licensure, all requirements **MUST** be complete with a grade of C or better, and a minimum GPA of 2.75.
