1. Pass EDUC 200 (or equivalent course) with a grade of C or better.
2. Achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75.
3. Pass the IL Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) OR receive a score of at least 22 on the ACT Plus Writing or a composite score of 1110 on the SAT evidence-based reading, writing + mathematics.
4. Be free of a felony sex or drug conviction.
5. Complete the FBI and State of IL Fingerprint/Background Check process and complete the CPS registration process.

\*For Education Licensure, all requirements MUST be completed with a grade of C- or better, and a minimum GPA of 2.75.
